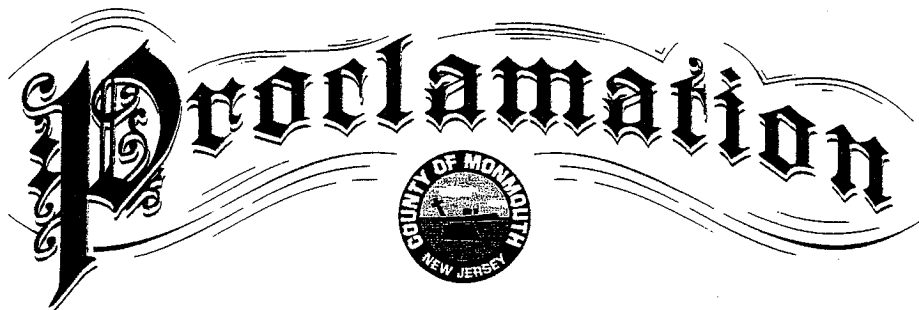


**WORK SESSION AGENDA ITEM #1 – PROCLAMATIONS**

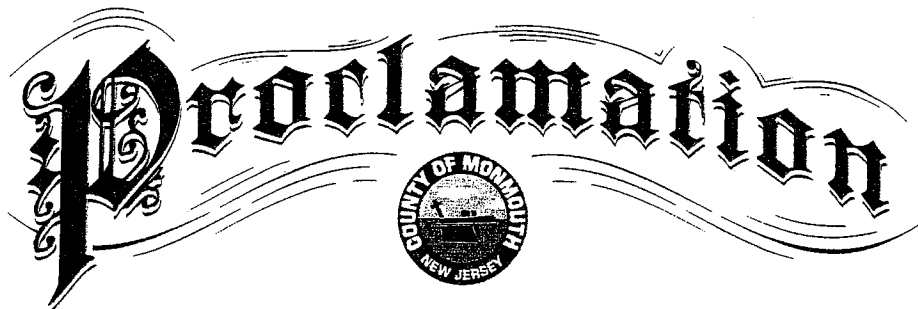

- **Freeholder McMorro** will be presenting a proclamation to the World Changers program, a group of 320 young volunteers who are rehabilitating housing and other buildings in Freehold Borough and Neptune – “*World Changers Day*.” Freeholder McMorro explained more about the program, stated that she attended a meeting with the group and thanked them for their work in Monmouth County.

*Honoring the World Changers Program*

*WHEREAS, World Changers is a unique approach taken by Southern Baptist and evangelical churches to help the youngsters of the community better understand youth mission projects through personal involvement; and*

*WHEREAS, the one week World Changers national work project began in the summer of 1990 with 137 youth and adults, who paid their own expenses, divided into crews and painted, repaired roofing and performed light construction on nine homes in Tennessee; and*

*WHEREAS, in 2007 World Changers coordinated more than 22,000 participants in mission ministries across North America at 87 locations on 1,800 work sites and 55 ministry sites and reported more than 950 professions of faith; and*

*WHEREAS, in 1992, World Changers expanded abroad with a project in Mexico, and today, World Changers has projects in 101 American and 28 international locations.*

*WHEREAS, for one week beginning on July 5, 2008, 320 youngsters from 28 congregations in 12 states came to Neptune New Jersey to work on projects which included housing rehabilitation, painting and landscaping; and*



**“World Changers Day”**


