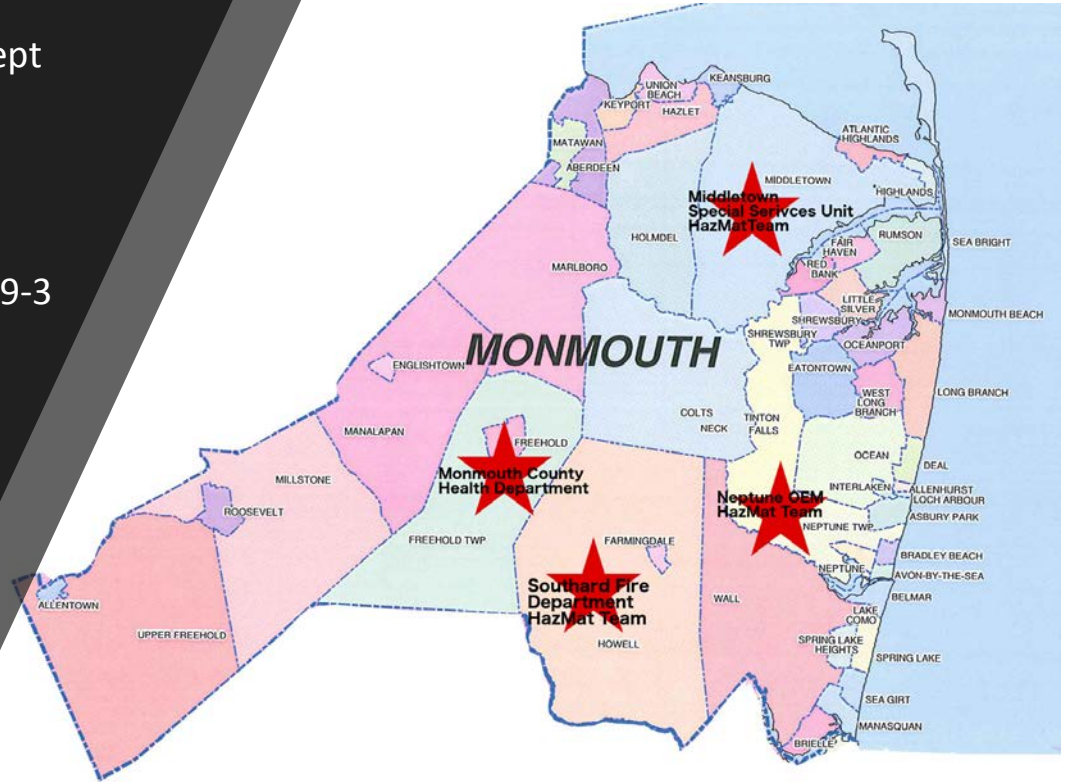

- To work within the Unified Command System
- To quickly and efficiently mitigate Hazardous Materials Incidents
- To identify unknown chemicals
- To help provide insight for you to assist in the resolution of your incident
- To provide safe monitoring, identification, and mitigation without putting your responders or the general public in danger
- Work with Fire, Police, EMS, DPW - **Any Agency**



When and How to Call?



- If it's beyond your capabilities, CALL.
- Contact Monmouth County Radio Room, Ask for “**Hazmat Task Force**”
- Specify if you want to consult or if you want a response
- Must provide a contact name and phone number of the IC
- Location of Command Post
- DEP Case Number - 1-877-WARN-DEP (877-927-6337)
 - (IC Must Get Case Number)

Old vs. Current Response Methodologies

Old

1. Level A on almost every call
2. Confusion over what product is involved, and how to handle
3. Extended scene times
4. Elaborate and Lengthy Decon and cleanup times

Current

1. Mission driven PPE selection based on “keep me alive 5”
2. Rapid entry so you start obtaining answers fast!
3. Scene times are significantly reduced by rapid classifications
4. Decon is simplified

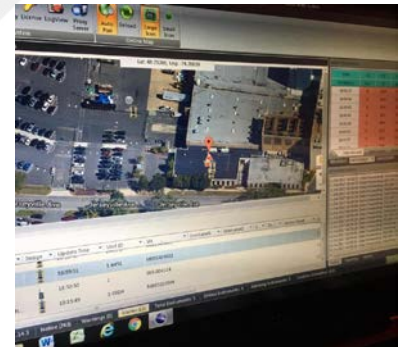

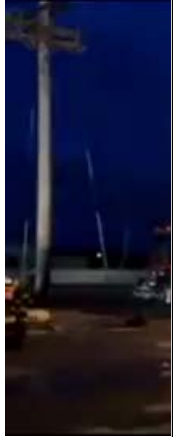
Response Capabilities

- Remote Advanced Air Monitoring
- **CBRNE** [Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear, Explosive] Detection and Response
- Unknown chemical identification and remediation
- Spill, Leak, Release containment or advisory
- Identify public safety factors such as evacuation radius, contamination radius and environmental factors
- Safely decontaminate personnel and equipment from chemicals and substances
i.e. Carfentanyl & Fentanyl



Response Capabilities.....Continued

- Chlorine (A/B/C)
- Propane Flaring
- Cryogenics (CO2, Liquid Oxygen, Nitrogen, etc...)
- Mass Decontamination
- Technical Decontamination
- Unknown Chemical Identification
- (50) Hazardous Materials Technicians
 - Tank Truck
 - Rail Car
 - Clandestine Labs
